Field inquiries from the field team regarding customer payments

- Monitor product price schedule to ensure appropriate booking of quantity sold
- Ensure the timely (daily) posting of transactions is maintained
- Ensure the correctness and completeness of all entries
- Review dispatch reports from the field sales team
- Oversee the invoicing of both Agents and Export sales
- Oversee the filing of sales invoice paperwork from the field sales and operations team
